News of the GreenNS Match Project

Conference: "Employment: Current Status and Future Prospects"

The GreenNS Match Project has been presented at a recent conference entitled "Employment: Current Status and Future Prospects" in Zaragoza on 26th October. This event was organized by "Zaragoza Dinámica", the Municipal Institute of Employment and Business Promotion of Zaragoza (IMEFEZ). The objective of this institution is stimulating the municipal policy about employment and business promotion in the city. The main purpose is the management of the municipal activity in areas of employment training, job orientation and employability, economic and business promotion and the socioeconomic research.

Project results achieved so far were showed in the framework of a workshop in which some relevant participants from public institutions and private companies took part. Public institutions were represented not only by the Chamber of Commerce but also by Zaragoza Dinámica, the promoter of the seminar, and the Zaragoza City council, with the participation of a consultant from the area of social rights.

On the other hand, the presence of private companies was also important and this made more interesting the event. One of these companies was the consulting firm "Nabata Asesoría", encompass within the cooperative "Grupo La Veloz" that develops several socioeconomic actions. "Adecco", one of the biggest solution providers in Human Resources in Spain, and "DKV Integralia - Anobium", a foundation focused on projects of labour integration of disabled people participated too in this seminar.

Multi-skilled profiles, technologies, new sources of employment and life long learning look to be the challenges of employment in the near future, at least in Spain.
