Last news of the GreenNS Match Project

On the occasion of the presentation of the results of the project, the Chamber of Commerce of Zaragoza organized in December 14, 2016 the multiplier event, “The new professionals of the green economy. Who they are and what training needs they have”. in which all project partners were present (Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Zaragoza and FEUZ in Spain, EEO Group in Greece, Inovamais in Portugal, and IHK Projektgesellschaft mbH in Germany), as well as representatives from the educational sector, business sector and the Government of Aragon.

Pilar Fernández, Director of the Training and Employment Department of Zaragoza’s Chamber, was in charge of presenting in detail the results: a State of the Art report on green economy, a Study on the green training needs of 15 companies, a Map of the green skills existing in the different countries participating in the project, a Report that includes some of the best practices identified in the market to link the supply and demand of skills, fifteen Roadmaps, linking fifteen Green occupations with their competencies demands and the training supply, and a final Publication that collects and summarizes all the work done.

In order to raise awareness of Green Economy, as the partners did in the State of the Art Report, and to provide an overall view of its importance in terms of employment, as well as its future trends, we counted with two first class speakers Francisco Barrio Moreno, Director of the Area of Sustainability and Use of Energy of the CIRCE Foundation (Center for Research on Energy Resources and Consumption), and Victor Viñuales, Director and founder of ECODES (Ecology and Development). The first one spoke about the potential of Green Economy in employment generation in Aragon, while the

second one focused on the contribution of companies to the Global Agenda: ODS and the Paris Agreements.

Some of the companies that contributed to this project were also able to participate and share their concerns about green economy with the public and to identify those green professional profiles in which they need to meet certain skill needs. Specifically, three companies participated representing three of the four sectors analyzed in the project: Industrias López Soriano, in the sector of recycling and waste treatment; Oviaragón, from the agri-food sector; and Vía Augusta, of the transport and logistics sector.

Moreover, with the aim of publicizing the offer of green competencies in Aragón, Roberto Santolaria, Director of the Agency of Professional Qualifications of the Government of Aragon, was in charge of presenting the different regulated training actions in the Aragon Community.

The identification of good practices that seek to reduce the skill needs of companies and the training offer was one of the most interesting results for the project partners. Therefore, with the aim of presenting some of these good practices, we counted with the participation of CENIFER (National Reference Center for Renewable Energies and Energy Efficiency) (www.cenifer.com), The Integrated Public Center for Vocational Training Pyramid of Huesca (www.iespiramide.es), and the San Jorge University (www.usj.es), focusing each one of them in those trainings tailored to the needs of the companies.
